The Charleston reunion will be held from October 5 to October 9 2022 (Wednesday to Sunday)

- The room rate is \$149.00 + 14% tax, and includes a buffet breakfast and omelet station each day for two.
- Hotel amenities include:
 - Free airport shuttle, laundry, WIFI, two restaurants, bar (complimentary happy hour each day from 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM), complimentary breakfast and omelet station, 24-hour fitness center, indoor pool and patio, shuttle service to outlet mall (90 stores) and 30+ restaurants, wet bar, coffee maker, mini-refrigerator, and microwave in each room. There are separate living and sleeping areas and a full work station.
 - Handicap rooms are available upon request.
 - The hotel is located about 9 miles from the historic district of Charleston.
 - Shuttle service is available to the Historic District visitor center from 8 AM – 11:30 PM for \$3.00 each way.
 - Shuttle service to stores and restaurants in Tanger Outlet area.
- The airport is served by all the major airlines and the AMTRAC station is less than 5 miles.
- Weather temperatures in Charleston area for October are – Day 75, evenings 62.

Activities

- The schedule allows for free time, so you and your family can visit the various venues of the Charleston area. Refer to the reverse side of the Plan of the Week.

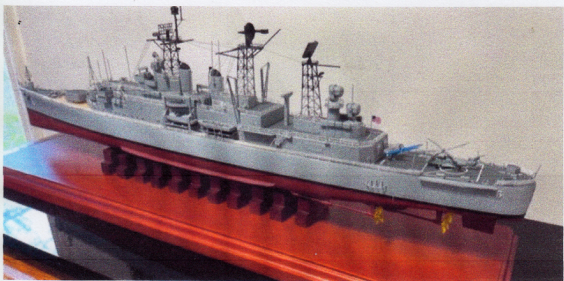
